# How To Clean ARC 8-Bay, 24-Bay, and 48-Bay Kiosks



## Before you begin:

- PLEASE DO NOT clean any cables or circuit boards inside of kiosk housing by removing panels. This will be handled by a technician.
- PLEASE DO NOT use glass cleaning liquids or wipes while cleaning the touch screen\*.

## Cleaning materials:


- 1. Approved for cleaning everything on kiosk exterior except touch screen: Multi Surface Wipes
- 2. Approved for cleaning everything on kiosk exterior except touch screen: Antibacterial Spray
- 3. Approved for cleaning touch screen: LCD/Tech Wipes
- 4. Approved for cleaning everything on kiosk exterior **including touch screen**: Multi-Surface Cleaner with Vinegar
- 5. Approved reusable towels: Microfiber Towels
- 6. All paper towels are approved for cleaning any exterior part of the kiosk.

### Areas to clean:


- Exterior:
  - Sides
  - Front
  - Top
  - Exterior of each locker window
  - Touch screen
  - Base plate (8-Bay only)
  - Camera window (if applicable)
  - Card reader and metal housing (if applicable)
- Lockers:
  - Top and side of doors
  - Metal, plastic, and neoprene surfaces in each locker
  - Inside of each locker window
  - Charging cables

### **Procedure:**

### **EXTERNAL CLEANING (Use only approved cleaning products listed above)**

- 1. Begin at the top of the kiosk with your cleaning cloth and wipe away any dust.
- 2. From the top to the bottom, wipe the kiosk locker doors one by one, taking care to remove all fingerprints from the acrylic windows.
- 3. Wipe down the center panel door.
- 4. On the center Base Unit, wipe down both the top cabinet door and bottom cabinet door.
- 5. For the touchscreen, use only the **APPROVED** cleaning supplies. If using spray, **DO NOT** spray directly onto the touchscreen.
- 6. Spray onto your cloth or paper towel and wipe the screen from top to bottom.
- 7. Using a dry cloth, wipe away any remaining cleaner from the touch screen.

#### INSIDE LOCKER CLEANING (Use only approved cleaning products listed above)

- 1. If cleaning empty lockers, log in to the tools menu.
- 2. Select Locker Management.
- 3. Tap open next to an empty locker.
- 4. Once the locker pops open, spray cleaner onto your towel and wipe the entire inside of the locker.
- 5. Wipe the inside of the locker door to clean any fingerprints off of the acrylic window.
- 6. Close the locker door.
